# Doctoral Short-term funding program

The next call for applications closes on 20.05.2024.

#### **Objectives**

The objective of VIP is to support researchers' careers, academic research and exchange. The Fellowship action targets researchers holding a PhD who wish to carry out their research activities abroad, acquire new skills and develop their academic careers further. The program helps researchers gain experience in Germany and expand their research network.

Period of Stay: 1 to 3 months starting Mid-June.

Note: Due to the administrative processing time of funding, entry to the fellowship is not possible after June 30th, 2024.

#### Who can apply for the Fellowship?

Academically committed doctoral candidates from all disciplines who are admitted to a state or state-recognized university for doctoral studies are eligible to apply for this fellowship program.

### What does funding cover?

The researcher will receive funding for the total period of the fellowship. The amount of funding depends on the country of origin and the period of stay.

We provide support in the form of:

- a living allowance
- a mobility allowance
  if applicable, family allowance
- if applicable, family allowances
